## Park Rules for Cimarron Eastridge Park

It shall be unlawful for any person to conduct any of the following activities without the authorization or designation of the Cherokee Metropolitan District Manager:

- a. to consume alcoholic beverages in any park at any time.
- b. to camp in any park or to set up a tent or any other temporary shelter unless authorized.
- c. to attach any rope, wire, or other contrivance to any tree or plant in any park.
- d. to dig, stake or otherwise disturb grass areas.
- e. to injure, deface, destroy, sever or remove park property.
- f. to leave a picnic area before his/her fire is completely extinguished and before all trash is placed in disposal receptacles provided.
- g. to bring in or dump, deposit or leave any glass bottles, broken glass, discarded vegetation, ashes, paper, boxes, cans, garbage, dirt, rubbish, waste or other trash in any park.
- h. to disturb the peace of park patrons or surrounding residents, particularly with loud or offensive language or conduct or unreasonably loud sound amplification.
- i. to launch or fly rockets, model airplanes or to propel objects such as arrows, javelins or other missiles in any park.
- j. to possess any firearms, air guns, fireworks or explosive devices in any park area except as otherwise designated
- k. to drive or park any vehicle on any area except upon designated park roads or park parking areas as designated.
- l. to solicit contributions for any purpose in any park without prior authorization.
- m. to exhibit or offer for sale any article or service in any park area except those person granted a concession permit.
- n. to gamble or to participate in any games of chance in any park.

**Use of park is at your own risk.**

Certain types of activities may be required to furnish proof of insurance for public liability and/or property damage in amounts established by the Cherokee metropolitan district.
