CHEROKEE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT PAVILION RESERVATION INSTRUCTIONS Effective May 21, 2019

- Cherokee provides access to the restrooms, during the reservation timeframe, available for public use at the Eastridge Park.
- Patrons reserving the Pavilion will be expected to bring in their own supplies.
- An electrical outlet is available for patron use. NOTE: The outlet is limited as to the number of devices used with each outlet having a dedicated 20-amp breaker.
- The drinking fountain is available for patron use, unless winterized.
- The District provides trash bags for use at the Pavilion.
- The District will attempt to respond during the reservation to investigate and possibly correct any issues that happen to come up, such as tripped breakers.
- The District will not refund Pavilion Reservations due to inclement weather.

The condition of the Pavilion will be checked before the start of the reservation and after the reservation time is complete. The damage deposit will only be refunded if the Pavilion is left in good condition. It is advisable for the person reserving the Pavilion to wait for the Cherokee staff member to check the Pavilion's condition while the patron is still there to ensure the Pavilion condition is verified to be left in the proper condition to have the deposit refunded.

THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE PARK:

- Drug Use, including Cannabis
- Camping
- Littering or Dumping
- Damage to District Property
- Solicitation
- Glass Containers
- Open Flames Outside of Designated Grilling Structures
- Excessive Noise of Amplified Sound
- Unpermitted Commercial Activity
- Flying Model Rockets, Fireworks or Explosive Devices

PARK PATRONS SHOULD:

- Place trash in receptacles
- Only drive and park in designated areas
- Keep dogs on a leash and pick up after them
- Respect the enjoyment of the area by others
